Florida “G” Statewide Firearm License Course

28-hour Class (20-hours classroom and 8-hours on the range)
FL “K” Instructor License #K1000034

The State of Florida requires in accordance with Florida Chapter 493, Class “G” licensed armed security officers to complete 28-hours of classroom and range instruction and certification under a State Licensed “K” instructor. The Raven Agency LLC (TRA) offers a three-day course that satisfies the criteria.

The Florida “G” Statewide Firearm License Course covers all information and certification required by the State of Florida including:

- (1.) Florida Statutes 493, 776 and 790.
- (2.) Firearms safety and handling.
- (3.) Civil Liability & Use of Force Issues.
- (4.) Handgun marksmanship skills and care and maintenance skills.
- (5.) A Certificate of Completion of the “G” Statewide Firearm course which will satisfy the education requirement of the Florida application, will be issued following the students passing a written test and a range test.
- (6.) A complete overview of the licensing application will also be provided.

ALL PERSPECTIVE “G” CLASS APPLICANTS PLEASE NOTE:

The State Mandated “G” Statewide Firearm License Course reviews the Florida Statutes and the principals of safe gun handling. It is a CERTIFICATION COURSE, certifying to the State of Florida that you have met the MINIMUM STATE MANDATED REQUIREMENTS TO CARRY A FIREARM IN THE COURSE OF YOUR DUTIES IN THE STATE OF FLORIDA. It is not a training class in basic gun handling. If you do not have the appropriate experience and gun handling skills to pass a live fire range certification PLEASE ENROLL IN A SKILLS CLASS FIRST.

TRA officers a PRE “G” SKILLS COURSE if needed. If you are unsure of your firearm skills please make an appointment with a member of the TRA staff BEFORE ENROLLING IN THE “G” CLASS and discuss your options.

Check the TRA calendar located on the bottom of the TRAINING page of TRA website for scheduled classes or call for special class times.

Additional class times or multiple student discounts can also be arranged. Please call TRA to discuss any special needs or requirements.

PREREQUISITES:

(1) Basic firearm handling and use skills, including the ability to draw from a secure duty holster and fire accurately in a timed course that includes stages from three (3) to twenty-five (25) yards.

All Class "G" license holders must also hold a Division of Licensing "D" Security Officer **OR** "C" Private Investigator **OR** "CC" Private Investigator Intern license. A copy of one of the above licenses will be required at the time of registration.

ALSO PLEASE NOTE:

As per the Division of Licensing web site [Proof of citizenship](#) or legal resident alien status must be submitted by individuals applying for a Class "G" license.

Section 493.6106(1)(f), Florida Statutes, and Title 18, U.S. Code, Section 922, require an individual seeking Class "G" licensure be either a citizen or a legal resident alien of the United States.

LICENSING REQUIREMENTS:

- (1.) Must be 21 years of age,
- (2.) Have no disqualifying criminal history. (A background check will be run as part of the application by the Division of Licensing.)

COST:

\$250.00 plus Florida Sales Tax.

TRA WILL PROVIDE:

- (1.) "G" Statewide Firearm course material.
- (2.) Range headset and protective glasses.
- (3.) All firearms and training equipment necessary for the CLASSROOM portion of the course.

STUDENT FIREARMS AND EQUIPMENT:

The "G" Statewide Firearm classroom session requires the use of a .38spcl. revolver, a .357mag. revolver WITH .38 AMMUNITION, or a 9mm semi-automatic pistol.

ALL firearms required for the classroom portion of the course WILL BE PROVIDED BY TRA. For the RANGE portion of the course a STUDENT provided firearm will be required. If the student needs a TRA provided firearm for the range portion please ADVISE TRA AT REGISTRATION. A limited number of firearms are available for student use for a cleaning fee of \$30.00.

PLEASE BE ADVISED. A Florida "G" Statewide Firearm permit is CALIBER SPECIFIC. CHECK WITH YOU EMPLOYING AGENCY as you will need to qualify on the appropriate caliber firearm.

ON RANGE DAY THE STUDENT IS RQUIRED TO BRING THE FOLLOWING UNLESS PREVIOUS ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE WITH TRA:

- (1.) .38 Revolver, .357 Revolver or 9mm semi-automatic handgun.
- (2.) **150** rounds of ammunition. (.38 spcl. or 9mm) NO .357 MAGNUM ALLOWED
- (3.) A minimum of three (3) speedloaders for a revolver or three (3) magazines for a semi-automatic. (The course of fire is three strings of 48 rounds with NUMEROUS RELOADS required.
- (4.) A quality duty holster and speedloader or magazine pouches and a belt that is capable of supporting the holster and the speedloader or magazine pouches. (NO cross draw, shoulder, SOB or ankle holsters.
- (5.) Comfortable clothing that will protect you from the sun and ejected brass.

Range sessions are conducted RAIN OR SHINE. Please wear CLOSED SHOES and bring appropriate jackets, etc., for the expected weather. If you wish to wear your prescription glasses please bring a brimmed (baseball type) hat.

When bringing a handgun to the RANGE session, the firearm should be brought UNLOADED and ENCASED. All student firearms will be subjected a safety inspection by a TRA instructor prior to live fire. ANY SAFETY ISSUES WILL BE AT THE SOLE DISCRETION OF THE TRA INSTRUCTOR AND WILL NOT BE OPEN TO DEBATE.

(TRA accepts cash, credit cards (MC, VISA, AMX) or company checks. (Sorry but no personal checks or money orders.)

ENROLLMENT:

Students are required to complete enrollment 72-hours prior to the start of the class. The State of Florida requires TRA to certify the completion of 28-hours of instruction and house keeping and enrollment processing cannot be included in the 28-hour structure.

At the time of enrollment the student will be required to sign a completed Student Contract approved by the Division of Licensing, a Code of Conduct and pay the full required tuition.
